

The purpose of this letter is to bring to the Law Court's attention a U.S. Supreme Court decision decided on January 23, 2012, subsequent to the date of Appellants' Brief in the above-captioned matter, filed on January 10, 2012. The case is *United States v. Antoine Jones*, No. 10-1259 (U.S. January 23, 2012)(holding that attaching a GPS unit to a vehicle without a warrant was a violation of the Fourth Amendment because the Government had physically occupied private property for the purpose of obtaining information). Appellants request that the Court consider this case as additional legal authority in support of the argument presented in Section V.E. of Appellants' Brief.
